(1). What country are French fries from?

The correct answer is Belgian

The correct answer is squirrels - the tails of squirrels.

The correct answer is November (when the Revolution took place the Russians were still using the Julian calendar).

(8). What do honey bees collect?

The correct answer is nectar.

(9). What is the colour of the "black box" in a commercial airplane?

The correct answer is orange - They were named after a Dr Black who invented them.
